_____ Winter Boots (waterproof is best – bring an extra pair if you have)

Sleeping Gear:

_____ Mummy Bag rated 0 to -45

_____ Second sleeping bag or warm blanket (layer into the mummy bag)

_____ Thermarest Pad

_____ Water Bottle (with water in it)

_____ Any snacks you would like to bring that won't freeze (in a Ziploc bag)

_____ Day Pack - for carrying extra clothing, water, camera, doubles as stuff sack
